

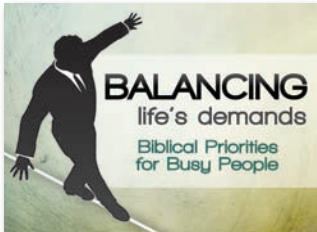

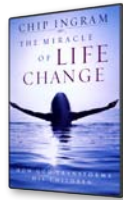


Are you busy, tired, stressed out, and stretched to the limit?
